

# **FULL RECOVERY PROGRAMS**

Children's Burn Foundation provides no-cost, comprehensive care to thousands of burn injured children each year. Our Full Recovery Program provides a critical safety net for families, covering essential services including surgeries, psychological support, and emergency assistance, that are often denied by insurance. Support continues through their 18<sup>th</sup> year, ensuring continuity of care at every stage of recovery.

### **MEDICAL & ACCOMMODATIONS SUPPORT**

Full Recovery supports over 4,000 children annually, including lifesaving, reconstructive, and functional surgeries. When needed, medical airlifts to specialized facilities are arranged. Care extends beyond the hospital, offering therapy, peer support, and emergency assistance with food, housing, and transportation. All services are provided at no cost to recipients.

### **SUPPORT GROUPS**

Specialized support groups help children, teens, young adults, and families navigate the emotional and social challenges of burn recovery. Programs serve families nationwide and a virtual component removes geographical barriers. The teen group supports adolescents transitioning into adulthood, while our new young adult program provides a peer bridge for continued healing. Parents of young children also benefit from dedicated virtual groups.

### **CAMP GUNG HO & FAMILY CAMP**

Young burn survivors and their families find safe, supportive spaces to heal, connect, and grow through a series of unique camp experiences. Held across Greater Los Angeles, children enjoy surfing, boating, art, and sports in a non-competitive environment that fosters teamwork, resilience, and joy. Family Camp provides a weekend retreat with therapeutic activities, peer support, and respite, giving families the chance to process trauma, strengthen bonds, and share their journeys.

### **CHILDREN'S HOLIDAY PARTY**

We help child burn survivors come together as a community and experience the joy of the holidays. While undergoing treatments at local Southern California hospitals, they can escape the stress of ongoing surgeries and find happiness and normalcy during the season. Each year, more than 500 child burn survivors, siblings, and family members gather for festivities and receive generously donated food, drinks, and toys.

### **GLOBAL BURN MEDICAL CARE & PREVENTION**

Over the years, Children's Burn Foundation has partnered with international centers of excellence in countries including Nigeria, Nicaragua, Iraq, Bolivia, Vietnam, Guatemala, India, and Pakistan to help children receive treatment closer to home. We've also supported burn prevention and education in Mozambique, Pakistan, and several Syrian refugee communities. working within local health and education systems.









## **PREVENTION & EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

Children's Burn Foundation educates almost 200,000 children, parents, and caregivers each year on the treatment and prevention of burns. Our partnership with the California Science Center led to the Fire! Science & Safety Exhibit, bringing burn prevention messages to hundreds of thousands more visitors annually.

### L.A. TROUPE SAFETY SMART

More than 1,000,000 students in Los Angeles County, from kindergarten through fifth grade, have benefited from the L.A. Troupe's interactive Theatre-in-Education program. This dynamic group teaches burn prevention and life-saving skills through entertaining performances. The program includes a coloring book to reinforce safety messages.

A western-themed module now teaches children how to avoid burn dangers outdoors and wildfire education.

### CALIFORNIA SCIENCE CENTER FIRE! SCIENCE & SAFETY EXHIBIT

Our permanent, innovative exhibit reaches hundreds of thousands of children and families annually. This engaging experience teaches visitors of all ages how to prevent burn injuries, prepare for wildfires, and respond safely in fire-related emergencies through interactive displays, immersive environments, and real-world scenarios.

### SAFETY SMART BURN PREVENTION FOR FAMILIES

Parents and caregivers—especially in vulnerable, at-risk communities learn how to safeguard young children from burns. The program is offered in English and Spanish, and delivered in daycare centers, nursery schools, Head Start programs, parenting classes, and health fairs, particularly in low-income areas.

#### **SAFETY SMART BABIES**

This program raises awareness among expecting and new parents about the risks of scald and contact burns. Collaboration with maternity departments, pediatricians, and healthcare programs across California and the U.S. delivers prevention education at critical times.

### LOOK OUT LUCKY!

This animated program teaches young children basic safety concepts about fire and hot objects through the adventures of Camo the Chameleon and Lucky the Curious Kitten. This popular program is available to preschools, parents, and caregivers, and includes an ageappropriate book with activity pages and a curriculum guide in both English and Spanish.
